You will need:
3/4 cup melted butter
3/4 teaspoon vanilla
2 eggs



- To make cookies, heat oven to 375°F.
- Grease cookie sheets.
- In medium bowl, mix butter, vanilla, and eggs.
- Stir in entire contents of jar. (If brown sugar has become firm, carefully break up with fork or chopstick)
- Form cookies using a small cookie scoop. Place 2 inches apart on cookie sheet.
- Bake 9 to 11 minutes.
